<p>Term 1: By October 15, students will be issued a Progress Report with comments on their learning progress, behavior and subject-specific competencies. By November 20, students will be issued a Report Card.</p> <p>Term 2: Students will write a midyear exam that will count for at least 20% of their term mark. By March 15, students will be issued a report card.</p> <p>Term 3: At the end of term students will write an exam that will count for 20% of their overall final mark. By June 28, students will be issued a Report Card.</p>
