<p>Term 1: By October 15, students will be issued a Progress Report with comments on their learning progress, behaviour and subject-specific competencies. At the end of term, students will write an exam that will count for 20% of their INTERACTION, READING, and PRODUCTION <u>term</u> marks. By November 19, students will be issued a Report Card.</p> <p>Term 2: Students will write midyear exams that will count for 20% of their INTERACTION, READING, and PRODUCTION <u>term</u> marks. By March 15, students will be issued a Report Card.</p> <p>Term 3: At the end of term, students will write an Evaluation Situation (ES) from the MEQ that will count for 20% of their overall <u>final</u> READING, and PRODUCTION mark. By June 28, students will be issued a Report Card. Final Results will be available through the MEQ Portal at the beginning of July.</p>
