| <p><b>Competency 1:</b><br/>Characterizes a period in history of Quebec and Canada</p> <p><b>Competency 2:</b><br/>Interprets a social phenomenon</p>   | <p><u>Whole class discussion</u> and <u>one-on-one teacher-conferences</u> to develop historical thinking, geographical thinking and an approach to critical analysis of historical documents and social phenomena.</p> <p><u>In-class worksheets</u>, <u>take-home reading assignments</u>, and <u>teacher-led small group discussion</u> to check and consolidate knowledge of historical documents and social phenomena.</p> <p><u>In-class practice</u> of skills and strategies necessary for the performance of intellectual operations: situating elements in time and space; comparing and contrasting different interpretations; analyzing sources critically; and, establishing causal connections.</p> <p>In-class, virtual, and/or take-home summative evaluations such as <u>weekly quizzes</u>, <u>tests</u>, <u>presentations</u>, <u>projects</u>, and <u>exams</u>.</p> |
| <p><b>End of Term 1:</b><br/>In October 2021, students will write a midterm test; In November 2021, students will receive a Progress Report with individualized learning objectives for each competency. At the end of term 1, students will write an end-of-term exam. The mid-term test and end-of-term exam will count for 25% of the term marks in each competency.</p> <p><b>End of Term 2:</b><br/>In April 2022, students will write a midterm test which will count for 10% of the end-of-term marks in each competency. At the end of term, students will write an end-of- year school board/MEQ exam.</p> |  |
