<p>Competency 2: Uses mathematical reasoning – 70%</p> <p>Sec 3 : Final exam is worth 20% of Term 3 grade, issued by School Board Sec 4: Final exam is worth 50% of Term 3 grade, issued by MEQ. (Moderated)</p>		<p>Class lecture and examples, individual guidance, guided instruction scaffolding.</p> <p>Repetition of important concepts.</p> <p>Evaluation: class work, exit cards, quizzes, and tests</p>
<p>Term 1: By October 15, students will be issued a Progress Report with comments on their learning progress, behavior and subject-specific competencies. At the end of term, students will write an exam that will count for a 20% of their <u>term</u> mark. By November 20, students will be issued a Report Card.</p> <p>Term 2: Students will write a midyear exam that will count for 20% of their <u>term</u> marks. By March 15, students will be issued a Report Card.</p> <p>Term 3: At the end of term, students will write a final exam given by the School Board (Sec 3) or the MEQ (Sec 4). By June 28, students will be issued a Report Card. Final Results for Sec 4 and 4R students will be available through the MEQ Portal at the beginning of July.</p>
