Sociological (Competency 1): <i>Studies Cultural Realities - 50%</i>		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Notebook entries which capture new learning related to cultural realities• Class discussions to explore and consider different cultural realities• Exercises exploring and comparing different perspectives on cultural realities• Inquiry projects: drafting clear questions, gathering relevant information, and developing a clear and coherent interpretation in thorough consideration of the cultural reality explored
Ethical (Competency 2): Reflects on Ethical Questions - 50%		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Notebook entries which leave traces of thinking about new learning• Class discussions to define relevant elements of an ethical question and explore different stances• Notes from discussions which explain reference points underlying different points of view• Exercises to explore possible implications and effects of different stances• Burning Questions to capture evolving stances• Inquiry projects: judicious selection of relevant ideas to sufficiently develop a clear and coherent ethical standpoint
Term 1: By October 15, students will be issued a Progress Report with comments on their learning progress, behavior and subject-specific competencies. At the end of term, students will write an essay that will count for 20% of their Sociological <u>term</u> mark. By November 20, students will be issued a Report Card.		
Term 2: Students will write an essay and have a project to complete that will count for 20% of their Sociological and Ethical <u>term</u> marks. By March 15, students will be issued a Report Card.		
Term 3: At the end of term, students will write a final exam that will count for 20% of their overall <u>final</u> mark. By June 28, students will be issued a Report Card. Final Results will be available through the MEQ Portal at the beginning of July.
