Term 1:

By September 29th, students will be issued a Progress Report with comments on their learning progress, behavior and subject-specific competencies.

Students will write a midterm test which will count for 10% of the Term 1 mark.

By November 16, students will be issued a Report Card.

Term 2:

In January students will write compulsory school board midterm exams that will count for at least 20% of their term marks.

By February 22, students will be issued a report card.

<u>Term 3</u>:

At the end of term students will write a Uniform ministry Final Exam from the MEQ that will count for 20% of their overall final marks. In June students will be issued a final report card.
